Day One: A Day in Medoc

We meet at the famous Chateau Margaux where we will take a guided tour of the property followed by a wine tasting.

Our next stop is the 19th century Chateau Beychevelle, often called the Little Versailles, where we will have



lunch in the magnificent dining room. Dine like a king on local specialties while you perfect your knowledge of wines and wine making.

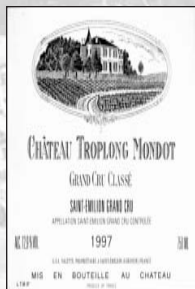
You will then be received at the Chateau Cos D'Estourel, an architectural marvel, where the history and wines will enchant you. This is followed by a

driving tour of the beautiful countryside with its miles of vineyards interspersed with picturesque chateaux. End the day with a splendid dinner at La Tupiña, one of the finest authentic restaurants in the Bordeaux region.

Day Two: Exploring St.-Emilion

You will be welcomed to Chateau Figeac where you will tour the cellars and taste some of Figeac's finest wines.

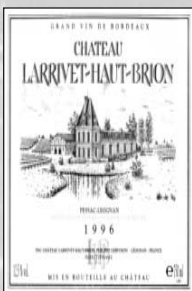
We then visit the Chateau Cheval Blanc and taste the wines, accompanied. Lunch will be served in an exquisite castle dating from the 18th century. Your host is Madame Sultzer who will conduct a tour of the property and prepare a gourmet meal, accompanied by wines from her cellar.



Next, we taste the wines at Chateau Angelus and visit the property with one of the owners, followed by a tour of the Pomerol region ending at the Chateau Gazin where Monsieur de Baillencourt will receive us and personally conduct a tour and wine tasting. We dine at the Saint James Hotel.

Day Three: Visiting Graves and Sauternes

Our day begins at the Chateaux Haut-Brion and La Mission Haut Brion, one of the most prestigious properties in the Graves Pessac Leognan region. We'll tour the cellars and sample wines.



The charming little inn, Auberge des Vignes a Sauternes, will host our lunch, where meats are grilled over grape vines in the chimney's hearth. Additional day's highlights include the famed Chateau d'Yquem, the Chateau Domaine de Chevalier and

dinner at Chapon-Fin in the center of the city of Bordeaux, one of the best restaurants.
